Harmony Hill School is currently credentialed as a Dual Diagnosis Mental Health & Substance Use Disorder Treatment Facility with Optum Behavior Health for those insured through RI Medicaid.

Licensed by (BHDDH), the Department of Behavioral Healthcare, Developmental Disabilities and Hospitals, our new program provides residential substance use disorder services with a supportive, therapeutic, and educational setting grounded in Harmony Hill School's trauma-informed treatment model.

Our Program Includes...

- A safe and inclusive environment for youth to live, learn, and recover, to meet their full potential
- A Trauma Focused Dual Diagnosis Substance Abuse Treatment Program
- *Seeking Safety* services provided in the scope of *The Recovery Model*
- 12 weekly hours of Group Treatment
- 1 hour per week of Individual and Family Therapy.
- Masters level clinical therapy, including individual and family work as appropriate. Group Therapy conducted by a Licensed Chemical Dependency Professional (LCDP) and/or a Licensed Independent Clinical Social Worker (LICSW).
